

Chat Central is a National Lottery Funded project where we help people to find others with similar interests, to have fun, get out of the house, join in with a hobby, get involved with their community and to find new friends, tackling loneliness and isolation in all its forms in Coventry.

We help people to explore their interests and start doing the things they want to do. Our support is tailored to the person's needs and can be anything from a one-off visit to us for information to longer term support. We have a range of activities including welcome sessions, walks, arts and crafts, yoga, pool, bingo, group volunteering and health talks. Our aim is to reach-out and help anyone in Coventry who is 18 and over, especially if they are bereaved, retired, a new parent, just out of hospital, dealing with an illness or condition that limits their ability to get out, recently arrived in the city or just out of practice with socialising. Some of our Chat Central participants were excited to begin their bushcraft for wellbeing course on Time to Talk Day, which encourages everyone to start a conversation about mental health. The course, ran by Warwickshire Wildlife Trust, Mind and TEAM, gave our participants the opportunity to learn bushcraft skills and to talk about our wellbeing in a peaceful outdoor setting. We were taught a traditional craft from Latin America called Ojos de Dios which involved winding wool around sticks we found in the beautiful Sherbourne allotments. Film Night

Chat Central attended Stoke Screen Film Club's showing of 'Rudy', a film set in rural Warwickshire. Rudy tells the story of a young girl trying to come to terms with her loss through a newfound friendship with a boy from Coventry. After the showing, BAFTA-nominated filmmaker/ director Shona Auerbach and producer Graeme Dunn gave a Q & A session discussing how they created the story and filmed 'Rudy' all around Coventry.

One participant, Kane, who has an interest in working in media said, 'I really enjoyed the film. I thought it was a great way to represent Coventry and show the good side to the city and as a guy who wants to become a filmmaker it inspired me to start making more on my own.'

Kane went on to explain how attending events through Chat Central has helped him. 'Chat Central has been good to me when I've needed it. I've been supported and listened to; they are good at doing that and I'd highly recommended it.'

Mission Possible: Guphill Brook Clearance with Warwickshire Wildlife Trust

Chat Central spent Valentine's Day working with our friends at Warwickshire Wildlife Trust cleaning up Guphill Brook, showing our love for the local environment. We were shown how to safely cut back trees, collected bags of litter and tidied up the area stretching from Buckingham Rise to Whitaker Road. Thanks to Warwickshire Wildlife Trust for leading the session and providing us with all the expertise, equipment, and hot drinks we needed! Our friends at Underground Lights invited us to their 'Lights Up' show which was held at the Belgrade Theatre. The performance, which was created by people experiencing social disadvantage, homelessness and/or mental health issues in Coventry & Warwickshire, did not disappoint! It was funny, thought provoking, moving, uplifting and the singing, which included a mixture of covers and original songs, was truly wonderful! One Chat Central participant, Kerri, said, "The show was really enjoyable, and I particularly enjoyed the funny parts, especially when the wedding cake had been eaten by a lady with the contents of the cake all over her face! I also found myself singing along to the Bob Marley tracks that the choir were singing. I'd like to see a production of theirs again in the future."

Kerri went on to explain how being part of Chat Central has supported her. "Chat Central has helped me when I was isolated after an operation. When you're alone, you can sink deeper into a rabbit hole that's extremely hard to get out by yourself. I personally had a fear of going out but with the support of Chat Central friends and staff, I have been able to overcome that battle and now attend some sessions. Even if you're having a bad day, just being able to have those conversations with the group can lift spirits along with trying new things that you could not otherwise have tried."
